## East Bridgewater Solid Waste& Recycling Program 2024-2025

This voluntary program is offered to East Bridgewater residents at a cost of \$500 per year (\$41.67/mth). The fee is billed quarterly and is included with your water bill.

## **Included in your services:**

- (1) 64-gallon trash bin and weekly collection
- (1) 96-gallon recycling bin and bi-weekly collection
- (1) Recycle Center sticker for access to the Recycle Center located at 877 Bridge Street \*refer to calendar for Acceptable Items and available dates 8AM-12:45PM
- Access to Household Hazardous Waste Day \*refer to website for dates and details.
- (1) Bulky item per week. A Bulky item is considered a (burnable) piece of furniture, wood table, upholstered chair, headboard, bureau, couch, dresser ect.
  - Please note if you have a recliner, the metal needs to be removed before placing curbside.
  - NO Appliances, metals, basketball hoops, grills, plastic patio furniture, all items alike must be taken to the Recycle Center
  - NO construction debris accepted as bulk item (sinks, toilets, doors, drywall, ect) contact DPW for local list of disposal locations
  - NO Mattresses- contact the DPW for a local list of disposal locations

Excess trash cannot be stacked on top of bins, the mechanical arm lifts bins 12+ feet in the air, if unsecure and falls out of bin, the driver is not responsible for any clean up. If you need extra trash pick-up we offer "yellow" trash bags, these bags can be placed curbside next to your bin or brought to the Recycle Center. Yellow trash bags can be purchased at the Town Hall or the DPW located at 49 Dean Place. If you find yourself continuously accumulating more trash than 1 bin can hold, we offer a second set of bins at discounted rate of \$20.87/mth.
